Regional Training Description

This 2019 CPI regional training provides a learning forum on cannabis trends, risks, and prevention strategies. It will address county challenges related to youth program adaptation, implementation, and assessment in a post-legalization era. This interactive, one-day training will introduce prevention professionals to local, community-based prevention strategies; engage participants in peer-learning; and offer opportunities to share successes and challenges.

Training Goals

- Provide information about current trends and challenges related to underage cannabis use and discuss effective efforts to address them.
- Understand how underage cannabis use can be decreased by addressing local risk by promoting or implementing protective factors.
- Identify and discuss existing regional and statewide prevention resources and tools available to address cannabis use.

Audience

County Prevention Coordinators, County department staff, contracted SUD Pv providers, community-based organizations, regional prevention coalitions, and other local collaborators.
